This page includes the most popular strips used on Mills machines of the 1920-1940 era. The Ten Stops, used on all goosenecks and early escalator machines, are available in plain fruit symbols or fortunes, white or buff color. The SP-1 Fortunes also in White or Buff. The Plain SP strips are probably the most used strip for Mills machines of the thirties, and available in White for earlier machines (CC-236) or (CC-536) or Gold (CC-2). The CC-319 Fortune strips is same readout as Mills CC-318 – These are not too common.

(The 10 Stop Plain and the SP Plain are no longer available in Buff.)

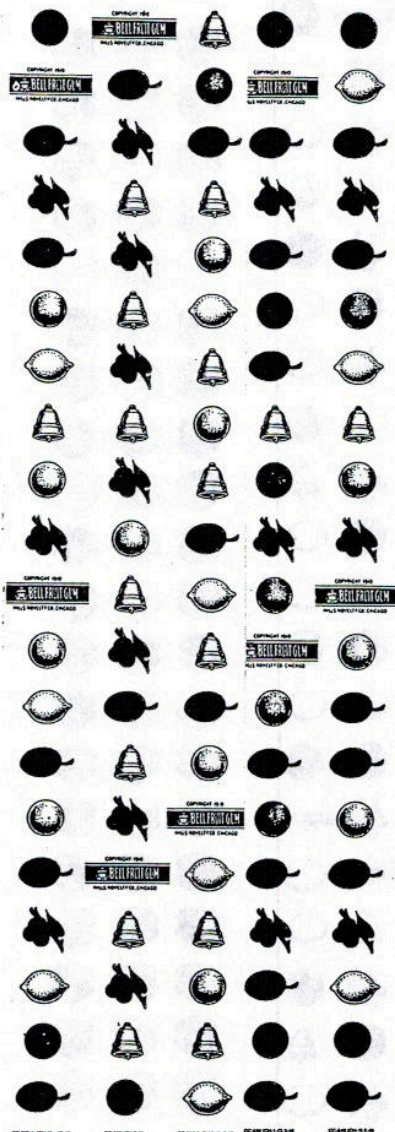

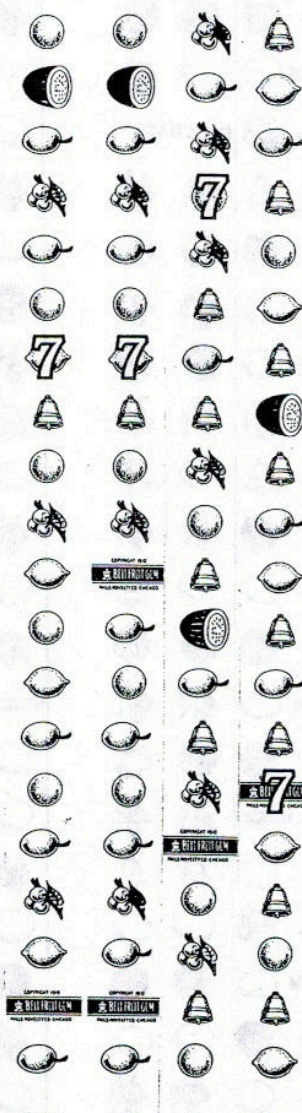
The CC-538 and 407's are usually used on later model War Eagles, Brown and Blue Fronts, and early Black Cherries. Occasionally on these later model machines, you might find some variations, so check the discs, they could be marked "B" or "J" -- an will need to be patched. The four strip set of Gold Award Strips will take care of 99% of the gold award machines, but there is a rare one which we have not done, and will not patch. Most Horse Head Bonus machines will have the CC-457 strip on first reel with a CC-407-J2 on second and CC-538-R3 on third. However, there are a few Horsehead Bonus machines with unusual readouts - we cannot accommodate those. The High Top Bonus set includes strips for discs marked BOC-1, BOC-1-B, BOC-2 and BOC-3. Strips on this page are available in Buff, Silver, Gold, plus the CC-538 and CC-207 also available in glossy white. (The CC-407 and Horse Head are no longer available in Buff.)

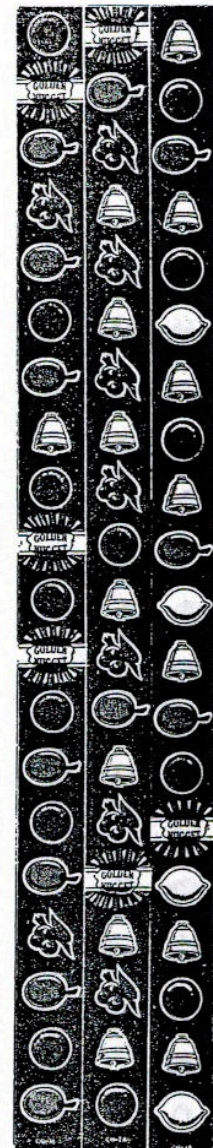

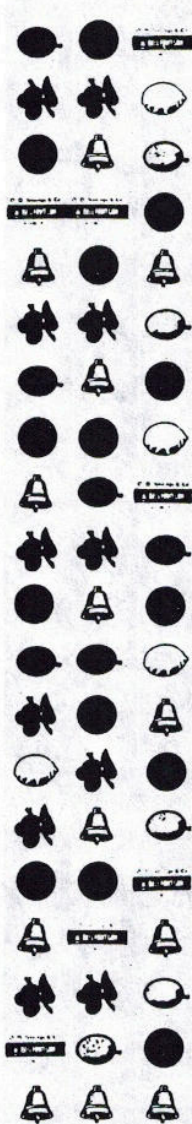

The 5 strip CH SET is used on most late model Mills with 2/4 payout. It includes the CC-539 and CC-540 strip to save patching. This set is available in Buff, Silver, Gold, Black and Gloss White. The "EJ SET" is used on the Mills 7-7-7 High Tops and includes the EJ-1-B variation. The Wild Deuce is another High Top variation and also a 4 strip set. EJ's and Wild Deuce are on Silver paper only. The last set on this page are the Golden Nugget strips and fit ONLY discs CH-1-C, CH-2-AS, CH-3-A. Black only. Golden Nugget strips not shown are available in Black. (5 strip sets) fit regular CH discs.

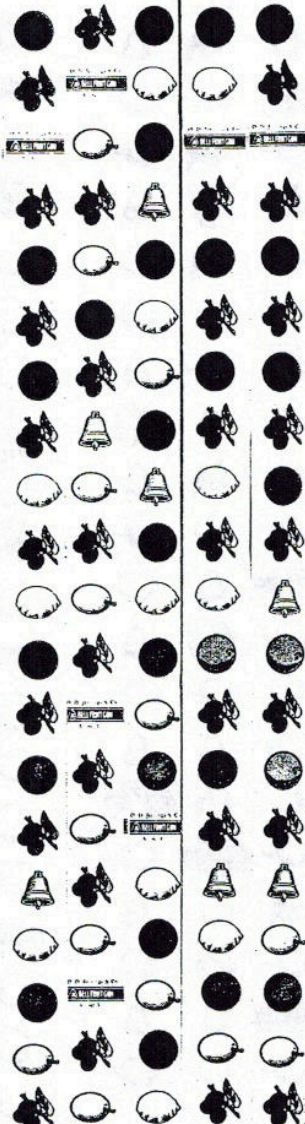

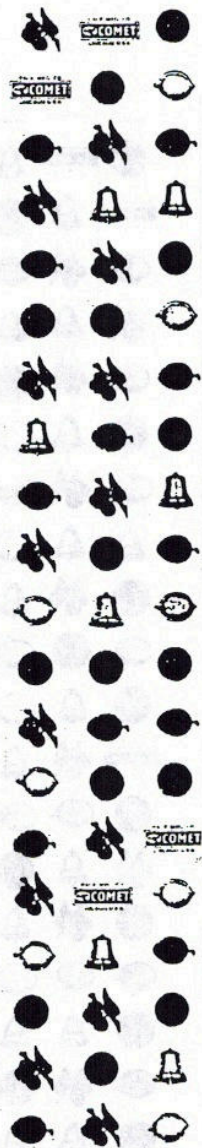
The Jennings 10 Stop Plain is available in 1-3/8" width and the 10 Stop Fortune is available in 1-3/8" or 1-1/2" width. These were used in the 1920's. 10 Stops in Buff color. The V-12-23 five strip set is found on Jennings of the One and Four Star Chief era, some variations can occur. LB-83MPS is of same era. Both sets available in Buff or White. The Jennings Today strips are available in 1-1/2" Buff color or 1-3/8" White - please specify.

# JENNINGS STRIPS

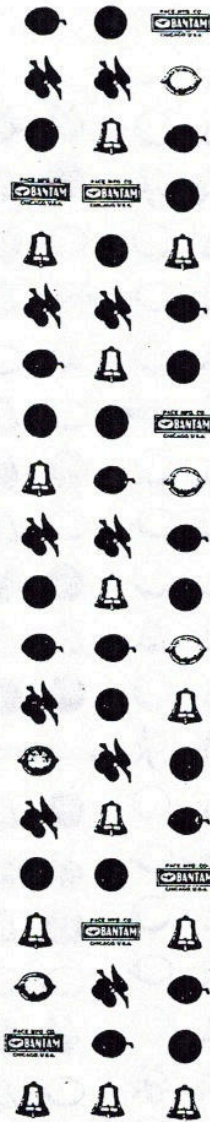


These 6 sets of Jennings strips are self-explanatory. The 54's are for a Cherry Pay Out; the rest for 1 Cherry pays. The V-12-70 is for machine with cherries on all 3 reels, and with minor patching will fit the V-12-88. The V-12-82XX is an early Tic-Tac-Toe strip used on some Club Chiefs and Sun Chiefs. Watch your old strips closely, Jennings was famous for making minor symbol changes, yet using same number on strip.

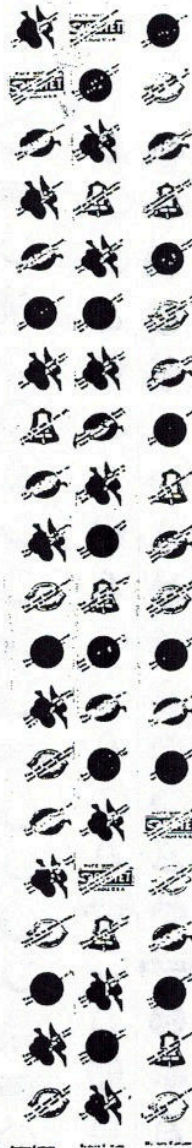
